Changes to Company Policies

Reveille Run will be making several changes to its policies effective September 1, 2009.

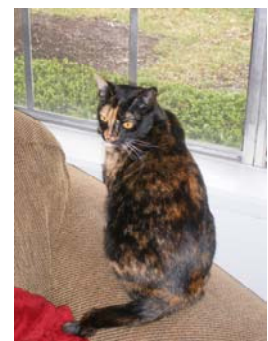
- ◆ The pre-pay discount for multiple visits will be discontinued. This decision was made in lieu of raising our rates and will not affect all customers. Pre-pay discounts for volume pet sitting purchases may still apply in certain situations and are at the discretion of the company. Payment for all pet sits is due at the time services are rendered and late charges will apply for outstanding invoices longer than 2 weeks.
- ◆ Reveille Run discontinued offering its Sleepover Service during the summer of 2009 due to the birth of Baby Treyce. However, RR will begin offering the Sleepover Service again this Fall to select clients with well-mannered, fully housebroken, non-digging, non-barking, non-aggressive dogs. (The Sleepover Service is not available for cats). In addition, the following policies have been added for this service: (a) Sleepover Reservations must be made at least 1 week in advance of the actual sit date; and (2) there will be a two day/night minimum for this service.

Dog Rules

Make-it-Yourself Pet Recipes

Precious Kitty Treats

1 12-oz can salmon with liquid

1 egg

1/2 cup flour

1/2 cup instant oatmeal, ground in a blender

Combine the salmon and egg in a blender; mix until smooth.

Add the oatmeal and blend well.

Spray cooking spray on a 9-by-13inch pan and spread the mixture in the pan.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes.

Cool, then cut into bite-sized squares.

Store in freezer.

Microwave Doggie Donuts

2 cups Whole wheat flour

3 tbs. Oatmeal

1 Egg; lightly beaten

1 tsp. Garlic powder

2/3 cup Beef or chicken broth

Place flour in a bowl, add egg and broth, mix well. Blend in oatmeal and garlic powder. Roll dough into a ball, roll out on a lightly floured surface to 1/2" thick. Cut with small doughnut cutters. Reroll scraps and repeat. Shape last bits by hand. Arrange rings on a shallow baking dish or on a sheet of parchment paper in a single layer. Cook on high 10 minutes or until firm. Let cool until hardened. Store in covered container when doggies not looking.
